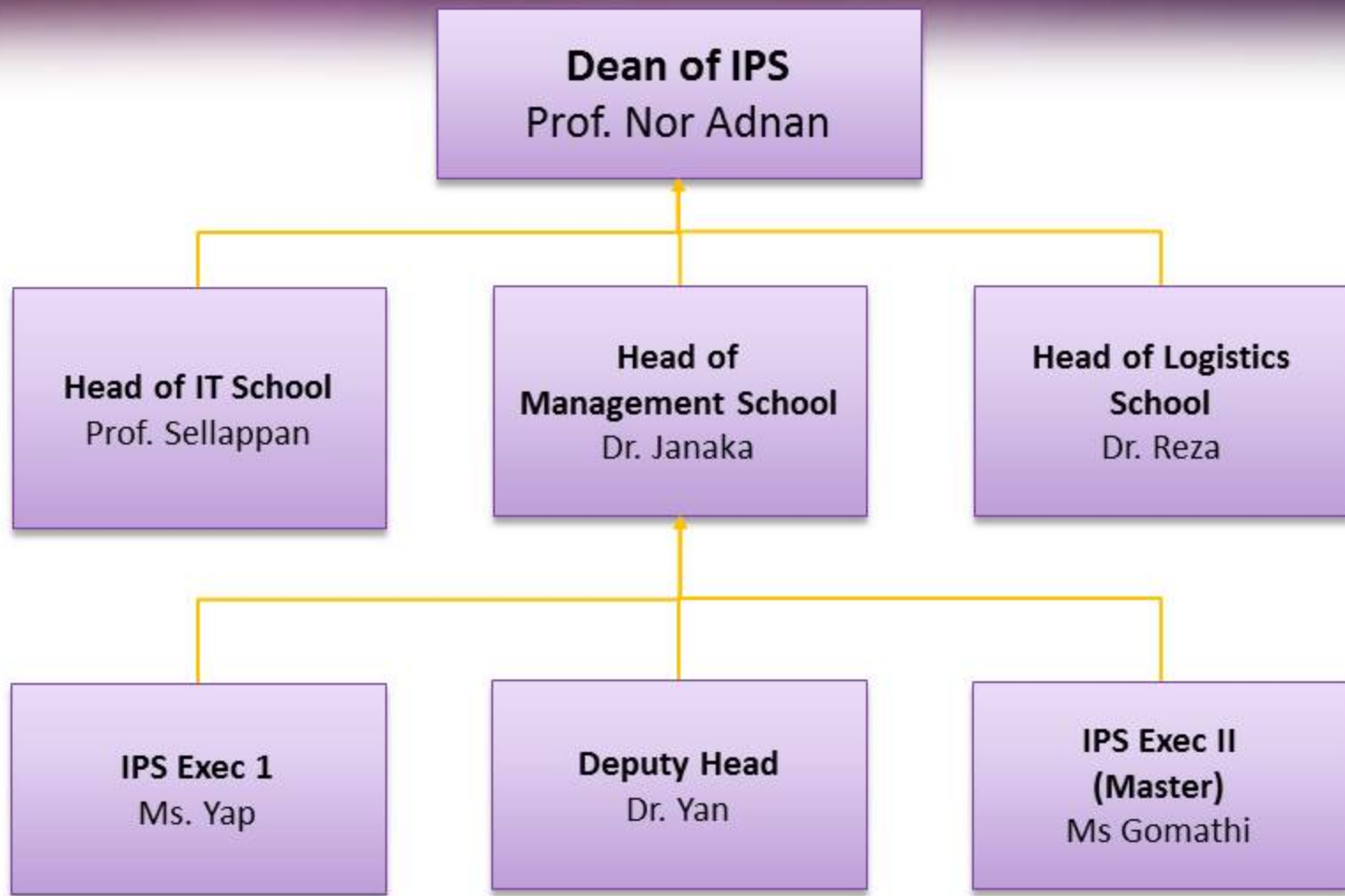

APPLY

A Master's degree First Class or Second Upper Class honours degree or CGPA of 3.00 or an equivalent qualification in a relevant field from a recognized university.

OR

In special circumstances applicants who have relevant work experience in an appropriate field and a Second Lower honours degree or a CGPA of 2.50-2.99

Language Proficiency: TOFEL score > 600 • IELTS \geq 6.5 (\geq 6.0 on each component) • Provide proof of English proficiency as evaluated through personal interviews with **MUST**
