Complete BSB50215 DIPLOMA OF BUSINESS pathway into RMIT, Australia.

The BSB50215 Diploma of Business is an Australian accredited qualification that provides the participant with necessary knowledge and skills to effectively function within the corporate environment.

This program is aimed particularly at the effective management of meetings, implementation of continuous improvement, business document design and development, professional development, quality customer service, project work and implementation of administrative systems.

Blended Learning International provides blended delivery of the qualification. This qualification is provided through the Global Development Learning Network (GDLN) at the American College of Higher Education, Sri Lanka.

Following the successful completion of the BSB50215 Diploma of Business, along with meeting the RMIT English requirements (<https://www.rmit.edu.au/study-with-us/international-students/apply-to-rmit-international-students/entry-requirements/english-requirements>), students will obtain a guaranteed entrance to one of RMIT's undergraduate business degrees depending on the degree selection.



Q How can I obtain a student visa to Australia?

A Students are free to get the services of any streamlined official Australian visa agent of their choice.

Q When are the intakes at American College?

A Admissions are open every month on a rolling admission basis and every month a subject will be offered.

Q Is it an in-house program or partially online program at the American College?

A The program is offered fully online, including the assessments, by Blended Learning International. Student support is provided by the American College and the DLC. Student support may include classes and lectures.

Q How will I gain entrance to RMIT?

A Your agent in Sri Lanka will lodge your application to RMIT as part of your visa application services. Blended Learning International can be contacted for assistance as students may require.

Q How will the course be conducted?

- A**
- ACHE will collect the students applications for BLI to enrol into the eight units in the BSB50215 Diploma of Business.
 - The course resources and assessments are all available online through BLI's e-learning platform.
 - Student support is provided by ACHE at the ACHE premises. The course is interactive and blended, thus, there will be lecturers, presentations, research and support for assessments.

Q How are the assessments conducted?

- A**
- With the support at ACHE, students will complete the assessments at the Distance Learning Centre (DLC), which functions under the Ministry of Public Administration & Management, Sri Lanka at their secure exam centre.
 - DLC will conduct the assessments under secure conditions.

Q When are the intakes at RMIT?

- A** The dates for students to commence at RMIT following the successful completion of the Diploma are as follows:

Semester 1 (February/March in any year). For this intake, BLI results are released mid December. This means students would need to complete by the end of October.

Semester 2 (July in any year). For this intake, BLI results are released mid May. This means students would need to complete by the end of March.

Q&A

Q Will I be getting a certificate on completion of one year?

A Yes, students will receive a certificate that states his/her successful completion of the “BSB50215 Diploma of Business” with the official BLI seal and NRT logo.

Q Is there an age limit to join this diploma?

A Students must be over 17 years of age.

Q What are the universities can I get transferred to?

A RMIT as well as many other Australian Universities. Please contact BLI at info@blendedlearning.edu.au for further information.

Q Can I pathway my Diploma of Business to RMIT to complete my bachelor's degree at RMIT?

A Yes, you can transfer to the 2nd year under our 1+2 University Transfer Program.

Q How will this program be taught?

A This program is delivered fully online by BLI. Student support is provided by ACHE along with the DLC.

Q What are the online resources available?

A The online resource will consist of course content including activities, practice questions and assignments for every unit.



Q What is the relationship between Blended Learning International (BLI) Australia with The American College of Higher Education (ACHE) Sri Lanka?

A BLI is offering its BSB50215 Diploma of Business together with the Distance Learning Centre (DLC) at the American College of Higher Education, Sri Lanka.

Q What recognition does BLI have?

A Blended Learning International is an Australian Registered Training Organisation (RTO Code 110068). The BSB50215 Diploma of Business is an Australian accredited qualification under the Australian Qualifications Framework.

Q What constitutes BLI's interactive BSB50215 Diploma of Business?

A It constitutes the following subjects,

- BSBADM502 Manage meetings
- BSBMGT403 Implement continuous improvement
- BSBADM506 Manage business document design and development
- BSBWOR501 Manage personal work priorities and professional development
- BSBCUS501 Manage quality customer service
- BSBCUS402 Address customer needs
- BSBPMG522 Undertake project work
- BSBADM504 Plan or implement administrative systems

Q What is the duration of this diploma?

A The diploma is scheduled to be completed in 8 months based on full time study from the time the login is assigned by BLI/DLC.

Q What is the minimum entry qualification to join the diploma Program?

A

- A) 6 passes in O/L + 2 year's work experience
- B) 6 passes in O/L + recognized course work of 8 months or more (Foundation program)
- C) 2 passes in A/L s

Q Do I need to have an IELTS Score?

A There are no English language requirements to study the BSB50215 Diploma of Business, but it is expected that students have a basic level of English in order to successfully complete all assessments in English. Please note that all international students must meet the English language entry requirements set by RMIT in order to enrol in an undergraduate degree. The English requirement for RMIT undergraduate business degrees are as follows:

- IELTS (Academic): minimum overall band of 6.5 (with no individual band of 6.0)
- TOEFL (Paper Based Test): minimum score of 580 (TWE 4.5)
- TOEFL (Internet Based Test - IBT): minimum overall score of 92 (with minimum of 20 in all sections)
- Pearson Test of English (Academic) (PTE (A)): minimum score of 58 (with no communication band less than 50)
- Cambridge English: Advanced (CAE): minimum of 176 with no less than 169 in any component.

Q How many credits (RMIT university) can be awarded for this diploma?

A 96 credit points will be awarded.
