

TRANSFER PROGRAM



A unique characteristic of American higher education is the transfer system, which allows credits subjects from one institution to transfer to another. It is not uncommon for students to transfer two or three times while

studying for an undergraduate degree. The credits earned by the American College students are recorded on a Keiser University transcript. These credits can be transferred to most of universities in American and elsewhere and will count towards an undergraduate degree. The American College will assist students in finding admission at the appropriate universities. Since many American College students take classes during the summer semester as well, they are able to transfer to the US and other countries in less than two years usually in 10 months.



Credits earned at one institution are transferable and acceptable as credits towards a degree at another institution. Colleges and universities in the United States will generally accept credits from

other institutions as long as the student has earned a "C" grade or better in the subject.



Choosing a university in the USA to complete a degree is a personal matter and depends upon the needs of the student and requirements of the university. Therefore the American College places great importance

on guiding and assisting students with the transfer process.

Students wishing to apply to degree-granting institutions in the USA must meet their respective entry requirements. The American College provides advising and counseling to all transferring students and helps them with the paperwork involved. Students are advised to follow the recommendation of the American College when making their decisions as to where to transfer. Expert information is necessary to make this decision and this information is best obtained from the staff of the American College who have had years of experience transferring students abroad.

♥ THE PATHWAY **TO YOUR DEGREE**

The American system of education is unique in that all students irrespective of his/her major are given the opportunity to experience a few subjects in a variety of discipline. The students be

major may Bio Science, Business, Engineering, Computer Science or even Hospitality Management - but the student is required to take 1 or 2 subjects in areas such as the Humanities. Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Mathematics, English, Foreign Languages, Computer Studies etc. This in turn realizes the American concept that every person should have some knowledge of the world around him in order to be a totally educated individual. The 'course planner' gives students an idea how to choose and plan the pathways to obtain their degrees.



THE FAST TRACK The American degree usually takes 4 years to complete. However, most of the students at the American College of Higher Education, Sri Lanka complete their degrees in 3 years by taking advantage

of the large number of course offerings each semester and by taking around 12 credits in the summer semester as well. Also students who join the American College after their 'O' Levels at 16 years of age have an added advantage of obtaining their degree by the time they are 19 years old and starting their careers early.



Since Canadian Universities follow, except in a few cases, a system similar to that of the USA, it is relatively easy for students to transfer to Canada. A growing percentage of students are showing interest in

Canadian universities, and a number of our students have transferred to York University, University of Ottawa, Simon Fraser University and University of Windsor.



On completion of the American university some students have transferred to UK, Australia, New Zealand, UAE, Malaysia, Singapore, Japan etc. and most of the coursework they had.

Completed were accepted towards a bachelor's Degree there.

HOW DOES THE TRANSFER PROGRAM OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF HIGHER EDUCATION BENEFIT THE STUDENTS?

- Of the 4-year American degree, study 2 years in Sri Lanka and transfer to the USA to complete the final 2 years.
- ✓ American College of Higher Education is the only U.S. education provider in Sri Lanka approved by a U.S. regional accrediting body, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), to offer an accredited USA university transfer program.
- ✓ Save almost Rs. 20 million by studying for 2 years of a U.S. degree in Sri Lanka at American College.
- ✓ Earn a world-recognized Associate Degree conferred by Keiser University, USA, in your field of study when you complete 2 years at the American College, Sri Lanka.
- Students who enroll for degree programs at the American College are simultaneously registered at Keiser University, Florida, USA, and become Keiser students.
- ✓ Enrolled students take the same US curriculum as Florida students while attending Keiser University classes in Sri Lanka.
- Keiser University Associate Degree is recognized by many countries such as Canada, the UK, Australia, New Zealand, and Malaysia for university admissions and credit transfers.
- ✓ Keiser University issues ID cards, PIN numbers, and Keiser email addresses to American College students so they can have the same privileges as students enrolled in the USA.
- ✓ Students will be issued a Keiser transcript and a Keiser University Associate Degree (2 years). The Keiser degree is recognized worldwide. Students can start degrees in Engineering, Biological Sciences, Psychology, Data Sciences, Business, Computer Science, and more while at the American College of Higher Education.
- Students can transfer to over 4000 universities and colleges in the USA and other countries, or to Keiser University itself, to pursue their higher studies.
- Students transferring to Keiser University will be granted a US\$16,000 scholarship per year.
- Students with good grades may qualify for many transfer scholarships ranging from US\$4,000 to US\$32,000 per year from many US universities.
- Students will have access to millions of books, journals, video clips, and other resources at the Keiser Learning Resource Center.
